7. I will participate safely and not endanger myself or others.
8. To the extent allowed by law, the organisers (including officials, volunteers, and sponsors) are not liable for any injury, loss, or death related to my participation.
9. I give permission for my name, image, or likeness to be used in Event photos, videos, promotions, or media without compensation. All attendees consent to possible photography/filming.
10. I will follow all safety instructions from organisers, officials, and volunteers.
11. I will uphold the spirit and conduct expected of a Karate-ka, respecting myself, my club, and Organisation.
12. Poor behaviour by athletes, coaches, parents, or supporters may result in exclusion from the Event.
